Notes

Interment fee does not include the cost of digging and preparing the grave which is arranged between the Funeral Director and gravedigger.

The definition of a **resident** is any person who has lived within the Parish for twelve months out of the preceding thirty-six months, periods spent in hospital or an institution outside the Parish during this period will count towards qualification. In addition, anyone who can demonstrate residency in Woodborough for 80 years or more will be classed as a resident.

The definition of a **former resident*** is any person who, while not currently residing in the parish or meeting the above definition for a resident, can demonstrate that they were resident in the parish for 15 years or more.

Interment fees and burial of ashes fees are charged at the time of interment. If a resident purchases a grave, and then moves away from Woodborough, then fees for a non-resident or a former resident would be applicable.

The Parish Council shall be entitled to approve the purchase of a grave/graves by non-residents.

No interment fee will be charged for the interment of a resident under the age of 18.

Fees will be reviewed periodically by the Parish Council.
