

**Minutes of the Extraordinary Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2021  
at 6.45pm in the Village Hall, Lingwood Lane, Woodborough, Nottingham**

**4410. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr Liz Anderson, Cllr Richard Pannell, Cllr Daniel Raynor and Cllr Colin Starke.

**4411. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

No additional interests were declared.

**4412. OPEN SESSION FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC**

The meeting was suspended to allow a resident representing the Bridge Club to make comment. She explained that the Bridge Club would return to the Village Hall to resume their regular booking after Easter 2022.

**4413. MINUTES OF THE PARISH COUNCIL**

The minutes of the meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> November were approved.

**4414. VILLAGE HALL**

It was proposed and agreed to hire the hall to Woodborough Preschool on term time Wednesdays, providing that:

- Preschool agree to relinquish 2-3 days per year for community events (with a term's notice)
- Preschool agree to grant access for any urgent maintenance works

Just Sing's request for a regular booking slot was noted. The group were likely to book Thursday nights up to the return of the Bridge Club.

It was agreed to accept a quote from Clearway to burn off the 10 perpendicular parking bay lines which ran along the side of the hall and tennis court (£290 + VAT).
